

# Pool Rules and Regulations

*Heritage Greens 2006*

**POOL HOURS:** 11:00 am to 8:00 pm

*(Pool may be closed due to inclement weather at the sole discretion of the lifeguard.)*

## **POOL RULES**

- 1. No pushing, dunking, or horseplay allowed.*
- 2. No spitting, throwing, or undue splashing of water allowed.*
- 3. No running.*
- 4. No glass containers.*
- 5. No front flips, back flips, or diving in shallow area.*
- 6. No hanging on lifelines.*
- 7. No conduct detrimental to safety.*
- 8. Obey the lifeguard at all times.*
- 9. No unnecessary conversation with the lifeguard.*
- 10. No Smoking or alcohol.*
- 11. Only one person on the diving board at a time.*
- 12. Only one bounce on the diving board is allowed.*
- 13. After going off the board, swim directly to the side.*
- 14. Do not swim under the diving board.*
- 15. Do not hang on the diving board.*
- 16. Lifeguards may close the diving board at their discretion.*

## **REGULATIONS**

- 1. The lifeguards have complete control over all activities in the pool area, and their instructions must be obeyed.*
- 2. Unsafe behavior could result in the offender being asked to leave the pool area for the rest of the day. Pool privileges may be suspended for up to 48 hours by the lifeguards, and for longer periods by the pool manager or Board of Directors, for infractions of pool rules and/or regulations.*
- 3. No person having infection, communicable disease or open wound is permitted in the pool area.*
- 4. Small floating toys, rafts, rings, tubes, or boards are allowed in the pool if not detrimental to safety. An infant or toddler under direct contact with an adult*

may use water wings, a life vest, or a ring. Direct contact means in the water with the child. Larger rafts, boats, ect. are not allowed in the pool at any time.

5. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult to enter pool area.
6. During regular pool hours, the pool will be cleared every hour, for a 15 minute period, and adults (18 and up) *ONLY* will be permitted to swim. An adult may take a non-swimming child under age 5 in the water, but must remain in direct contact with the child. No children allowed in the lap lanes during adult swim.
7. Animals are not allowed in the pool area at any time.
8. Proper swimming attire is required in the pool area at all times.
9. All members of the Association shall be responsible for damaged property caused by family and/or guests.
10. Baby-sitting Rule: A non-swimming child must be with a responsible baby-sitter. A non-swimming child is any child who has not passed the swimming test. The swimming test consists of swimming on length of the pool without stopping. If the lifeguard determines the baby-sitter is not supervising the child satisfactorily, both will be asked to leave the pool area.
11. Radios/boom boxes are allowed only if they are kept at a volume that does not disturb other people using the pool area. The lifeguard will determine acceptable volume levels.
12. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades, etc. are not allowed in the pool area.
13. Residents are required to sign in upon entering pool area for each visit.
14. Residents are limited to two (2) guests per visit.
15. The play equipment is for use by children 5 and under only.
16. Parents are responsible for supervising their children at all times.

### BABY POOL

1. The baby pool is for use by children 5 and under only.
2. Untrained children *MUST* wear a swim diaper or snug fitting plastic pants.
3. *NO LIFEGUARD* is provided for the baby pool.
4. *PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CHILDREN USING THE BABY POOL.*
